

Kleenex holder - overlapped edges

Cut 1 rectangle 5 ½ x 7 ½

Cut 1 rectangle 5 ½ x 8

Place right sides together and sew both short sides; Iron both seams - the inside lining will fold over to outside

Fold over to right side - approx 2" on each side with trim side on bottom overlapping slightly

Sew sides - reinforce overlap area; Sew across corners approximately ¼ inch if desired and turn right side out

Kleenex Holder - 4 Square

Cut 3 rectangles 5 ½ x 3 ½

Cut 2 squares 3 ½ x 3 ½

Fold 2 of the rectangles in half wrong sides together - long

Fold the 2 squares in half and iron

Place the last rectangle right side up and place the 2 long rectangles on top folded edges touching. Layer the small rectangles on top raw edges to the outside edge.

Place the top right and lower left of small rectangles under the long rectangles.

Sew seam around all sides and turn right side out

Kleenex holder - single layer with trim

Cut 1 rectangle 5 ½ x 6 ½

Cut 2 rectangles 5 ½ x 1 ½

Fold the 2 smaller rectangles in half long ways wrong sides together

Sew raw edges across short sides, press to larger rectangle

Sew decorative stitch along seams or straight stitch ¼ inch away from seam allowance

Fold right sides together, edges touching or overlapping slightly and sew along short sides, reinforcing along overlapped area

Sew across corners approximately ¼ inch if desired and turn right side out
