### Publicity/Public Relations - (OPEN Position)

Friday October 6th, we will set up the tent to sell tickets for the Presentation Quilt at the Friday Doodle Market from 5pm - 8pm in Pickens at the Doodle Trail head. We have enough people to work the booth but if you are out and about that night, stop by to see us and check out the market!

As part of our public relations, The UpCountry Quilters Guild displays quilts at the Pickens Chamber of Commerce and the Clemson Extension Office. We have recently received a call from the Table Rock Lake State Park asking us to resume hanging a quilt in their visitor center. So we will need 3 quilts for each quarterly rotation. Any size is welcome (Throw, Twin, Full or Queen), although the Table Rock site is great for a larger size quilt. The quilts do need to have the standard 4" size hanging sleeve. - Crib Size children's (45" x 60") <u>3 Yard Quilts | Quilt Patterns & Books | Fabric Cafe</u> will work for this category. There are many free patterns on this website, and they take 1 yd of 3 different fabrics for the quilt top and 3 yards for backing.
- Twin Sizes 72" x 90"
- Queen size 90" x 108"
